



## PREVENTION

We all have to take precautions ourselves to a certain extent. This way, in the event of a crisis, emergency services can concentrate on those who are unable to help themselves.

### My Checklist

- Assessment of personal dependence on electricity
- Backup of important documents and telephone numbers (digital or as a copy; birth certificate, identity card, etc.)
- Emergency luggage and cash
- Storage of drinking water, non-perishable food & hygiene articles (including service water for toilet flushing and personal hygiene)
- Stocking up on medication and first aid materials
- Fuel reserve in the vehicle
- Procurement of electricity-independent devices (candles and matches, crank radio, flashlight, solar power bank, etc.)

## WARNING

In the event of an emergency, the population is warned by:

- Sirens
- Announcements from vehicles of the fire department or police vehicles
- Cell broadcast via SMS
- NINA or KATWARN warning apps: available in the app stores free of charge

### You should know these siren signals:

	<b>One minute rising and falling tone</b>	<b>Warning of danger</b> Turn on the radio
	<b>One minute continuous tone</b>	<b>all-clear</b>
	<b>15 seconds continuous tone</b>	<b>test alarm / technical test</b>

### If you are warned:

- Keep calm and go to your building or apartment
- Close doors and windows
- Receive information via radio, TV, internet or warning apps
- Inform neighbors, provide help if necessary

# EMERGENCY INFO POINTS

Power failures can occur as a result of storms, major emergencies or other disasters. Power failures are often rectified in a short time. In emergency situations, however, it can take longer for the power to be restored.

Significant disruption to daily life is to be expected. The heating fails, there is no more light and even the kitchen remains cold. With the failure of landline and cell phone networks, emergency calls can not be made via 110 and 112. It is also difficult to obtain reliable information about the current situation.

If the power goes out for a longer period of time or the emergency number can no longer be reached, the emergency info points in the city are activated. You can report emergencies there and obtain further information. You will also find contact persons on site for important questions to the administration. The emergency info points are used to make an emergency call and are not mobile emergency ambulances. They also do not provide food, warming facilities and the like.

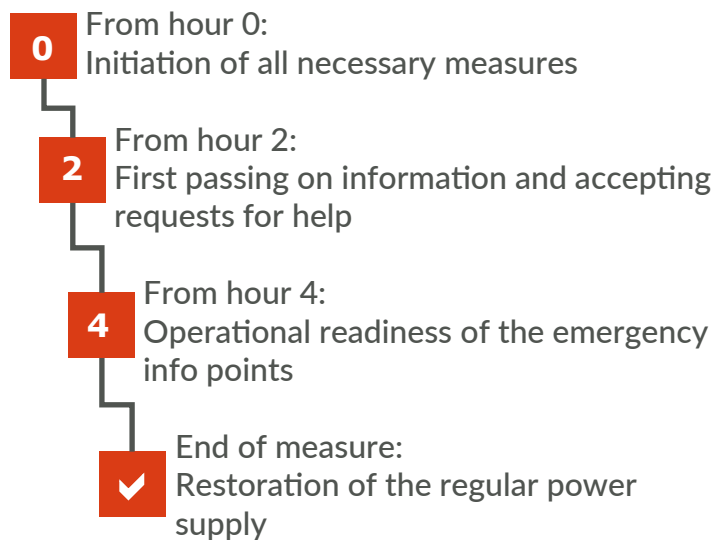


You can recognize the emergency info points by this sign.
